

Immigration Attorney Position Available

The Hispanic Committee of Virginia (www.hcva.org), a nonprofit organization located in Northern Virginia, seeks a part-time immigration staff attorney to provide legal assistance and representation to Hispanic immigrants seeking to adjust their immigration status or obtain citizenship. Staff attorney will also assist with community immigration legal education and outreach and with the recruitment and training of pro bono attorneys and program interns. Candidates must have a jurisprudence degree from a recognized and accredited institution and have admission to the Bar of any state. Candidates must also have at least two years of prior experience practicing immigration law with administrative responsibilities. Candidates must be fluent in oral and written Spanish, have strong communications skills and strong advocacy skills and client-focus. Computer literacy and experience with legal case management software preferred. Experience in the nonprofit sector, particularly working with low-income Hispanic clients preferred.
